### **1. Unfilled MCR Committee Positions: BME Rep, Disabilities Rep, JCR Liaison.**

### **2. Cinema Scheme!**

The MCR is trialling a scheme this term to allow MCR members to get a 50% refund on cinema tickets! The conditions are:

- One cinema ticket per student, per term.
- There will be a 50% refund, which will be put on your battels.
- The ticket must be a 2D student ticket, and must have been purchased at a cinema in Oxford.

If you want to take part in this scheme, put your cinema ticket, clearly (and legibly!) labelled with your name and with the price clearly visible, in the MCR slot in the pidge room, which is next to the laundry card machine and is labelled "MCR and President". There will be an envelope inside; just leave the ticket in there. 50% of the price will be credited to your battels.
