We are looking for healthy volunteers aged 18-50 years to take part in a study investigating how a single dose of the medication losartan affects learning and information processing, using computer tasks and EEG. Losartan is currently used to treat high blood pressure. However, we think that it may also enhance the effectiveness of psychological therapies
